

ADL Convergence/Catalyst Approach

ADL was launched in the fall of 1997. ADL met with industry, higher education and government experts to determine the state of the art. Also ADL joined the leading technology standards groups around the world. These included AICC, IEEE, ARIADNE, ALIC and IMS. The initial standards work was not progressing as fast as was needed. This was in part because there was a need for a common reference model to “connect” the work from many parts of the world. The SCORM was created as a concrete starting point for implementation of next generation e-Learning technology. ADL released a draft version of SCORM in 1999, SCORM Version 1.0 in 2000, SCORM Version 1.1 and 1.2 on 2001.
