to the ADL Co-Lab Alexandria

From Reagan National Airport & Points North (Distance 8 miles):

Follow signs to I-395 SOUTH. Take Exit 4 (West) onto Seminary Rd. At the second traffic light, turn left onto N. Beauregard St. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Nottingham Drive/Mark Center Dr. Take the first right onto Highview Lane. Building 1901 will be the red brick building on the right.

From Points South:


From I-395, turn right on Exit 4 (West) onto Seminary Road. At the second traffic light, turn left onto N. Beauregard Street. Turn left onto Nottingham Drive/Mark Center Drive from N. Beauregard Street. Turn right onto Highview Lane. Building 1901 will be the red brick building on the right.

From Dulles Airport (Distance 30 miles):

Take the Dulles Access Rd. to I-495 going towards Richmond (to the right). Follow I-495 until you see signs for I-395/95 Interchange (395 goes north; 95 goes south). Take the left hand exit to I-395 NORTH toward Washington. Continue with directions from I-395 above.

Visitor Parking:

Parking Garage 1851: Visitors must enter through the front gate to receive a ticket from the machine. Visitors may park in any space not marked as RESERVED. All day parking is \$7.50 per vehicle.


